ALCOHOL POLICY

It is recognized that operating a motorcycle (or other motor vehicle) is a dangerous act that can present the operator with situations that may require the timely assessment of the situation and the immediate execution of maneuvers requiring an extremely high level of skill and concentration.

It is recognized that the consumption of alcoholic beverages can interfere with the ability of the operator of a motorcycle (or other motor vehicle) to assess situations and execute maneuvers requiring high skill levels to the best of the operator's ability.

In regard for the operator's safety and the safety of any Chapter member involved in a Chapter-sponsored event, it is the Ghost River Chapter's policy to organize Chapter events in a manner which does not combine motor vehicle operation with alcohol consumption.

Specific examples of the Chapter's policy include, but are not limited to the following examples.

Alcohol will not be consumed before or during Chapter rides. A Chapter member will be asked to not join the Chapter ride or asked to separate from the Chapter ride if alcohol consumption by the Chapter member is observed.

If all efforts to separate the Chapter member who is in conflict with this policy from the ride are unsuccessful, the Chapter ride will be terminated.

Chapter-sponsored rides to locations such as restaurants that serve alcoholic beverage will terminate upon arrival at such location.

Chapter-sponsored rides of several days will be organized so that the sponsored portion of the ride terminates at the specified location for each day's stop. Alcohol consumption by any Chapter member during the ride will be cause for terminating that day's portion of the ride.

Alcohol will not be sold nor provided by the Chapter at Chapter-sponsored events.
